

Stroke Participants Needed!

Using a newly developed music app and piano to improve your hand function after stroke!



Study Purpose

We want to understand how we can use music and current technology (e.g., iPad) to help stroke survivors get better!

In this <u>4-week study</u>:

- We will visit you <u>2 times</u> at your home (before and after the 4 weeks)
- (2) We will provide you <u>an iPad</u> and <u>a</u> <u>piano</u> for the 4-week in-home training.
- (3) You will be encouraged to use the iPad app and piano for <u>at least 1 hour/day</u>.

<u>Requirements</u>

- Above 18 years of age
- Community-dwelling
- NO prior piano experience is needed!!

<u>Benefits</u>

- The in-home piano therapy may improve hand function for people affected by a stroke.
- This therapy has the potential to provide a cost-efficient therapy to stoke survivors at home, and supplement existing in-person therapy in clinics.
