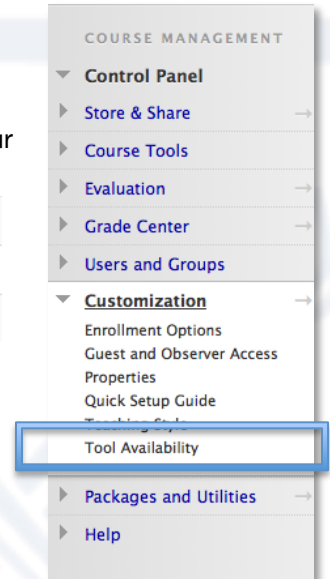




Activating Blackboard Analytics for Learn

1. On the **CONTROL PANEL**, expand the **CUSTOMIZATION** section and select **TOOL AVAILABILITY**
2. Scroll down the **Tool Availability** page, and check the boxes next to **COURSE ANALYTICS (INSTRUCTOR REPORTS)** and/or **COURSE ANALYTICS (STUDENT REPORTS)**. Click **SUBMIT** to update your settings.

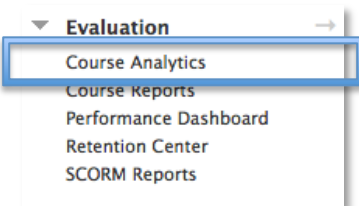
NOTE:

When **COURSE ANALYTICS (INSTRUCTOR REPORTS)** is made available, reports can be accessed by users with the role of Instructor, Teaching Assistant, or Grader. Students, Course Builders, and Guests do not have access to Instructor Course Analytics.

TIP:

Checking the box next to **COURSE ANALYTICS (INSTRUCTOR REPORTS)** and leaving the **COURSE ANALYTICS (STUDENT REPORTS)** unchecked will allow the instructor to view course reports, but prevent students from accessing their personal analytics.

3. Once made available, Instructors can access course analytics by expanding the **EVALUATION** section of the control panel, and selecting **COURSE ANALYTICS**.
