

Application for the Spring, 2023 CRA Study Program

ABOUT THE CRA STUDY PROGRAM

The CRA Study Program at Emory University is a guided, self-study program designed to assist research administrators in preparing for the Certified Research Administrator (CRA) exam. The program is not meant to be the sole source of preparation for the CRA exam, nor is it meant to be a guarantee that participants will pass the exam. It is designed to guide participants through the comprehensive body of knowledge represented on the CRA exam and to provide sample questions representative of exam questions as well as insights from individuals who have passed the CRA exam.

The CRA Study Program is held via Zoom during the months before the exam period. For the **Spring 2023 CRA** exam, study program participants will meet via Zoom every Friday for one hour from **January 13 – April 7, 2023, from 12:00 – 1:00 PM ET**.

ABOUT THE CRA EXAM

The CRA exam is offered in the spring and fall by an independent certifying body, the Research Administrators Certification Council ([RACC](#)). The material covered by the exam is referred to as the “Body of Knowledge,” and it covers all areas of research administration including collection and dissemination of information; legal requirements and sponsor interface; financial management; and general management.

The exam is rigorous and must be taken at a designated site administered through the Professional Testing Corporation. In four hours, test-takers must answer 250 questions that cover the full spectrum of research administration. There are multiple test sites within each state. Applicants select a test site and date within a testing window. The online application consists of eligibility requirements and an application fee of \$395.

CRA STUDY PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

- Individuals interested in participating in the CRA Study Program must submit the completed application form below to tricia.callahan@emory.edu by 5:00 PM ET on January 6, 2023.
- Applicants must have supervisor approval to participate.
- Applicants must be eligible for the Spring 2023 CRA exam. Exam eligibility requirements include:
 - Bachelor’s or advanced degree and three (3) years of professional experience in research administration or sponsored programs administration in a sponsoring or recipient organization or the equivalent in a self-funded organization, -OR-
 - Associate’s degree and five (5) years of professional experience in research administration or sponsored programs administration in a sponsoring or recipient organization or the equivalent in a self-funded organization, -OR-
 - No degree and six (6) years of professional experience in research administration or sponsored programs administration in a sponsoring or recipient organization or the equivalent in a self-funded organization.
