E-only reserves suggested – allow extra time for finding ematerials and scanning print materials

E-Books – search <u>discoverE</u> for full-text e-books and work with your subject librarian to <u>locate</u>, <u>acquire</u>, <u>and access e-books</u> for your course

Textbooks – plan to offer <u>free</u> or <u>affordable options</u>, since availability, cost, and shipping pose challenges for students; consider existing e-book content in <u>discoverE</u> for course texts

Streaming video – check <u>discoverE</u> for current licensed streaming content, review our <u>major streaming providers</u>, and <u>order new streaming films</u> 4-6 weeks in advance (for licenses)
