The conditions attached to loans by IMF and WTO since early 1950s



Changed over time

SA Programs - 1970s SA loans (part of Program) - Robert McNamara - 1980 PRSPs - 2002



Countries who have utilised SAPs

India - largest recipient since 1990

36/47 countries in Africa

























CONTROVERSIES

Encourage to become self-sufficient

Create cycle of self dependence Conditional loans = neocolonialism SAPs reduced standard of living Countries have less policy freedom
